Fresh from completing an Industrial Ceramic Design MA at Staffordshire University, Rachel is launching a new range of work and an international career, with lots of new designs and shapes to come. New tableware pieces include 'Editions' a range which captures the simple fluid throwing style of Rachel's work but can be produced consistently in larger quantities for the trade market. New this year is decoration using platinum lustre screen-prints of simple lines and brushstrokes to enhance the pared down forms.

Rachel Dormor Ceramics was established in 2001 with the help of the Prince's Trust and Rachel has just been awarded an Arts Council grant to develop international trade and will be exhibiting with the Crafts Council and Flow Gallery at 'Handmade' at The

International Gift Fair in New York this August. The full range will also be on display at 100%Design: Futures at Earls Court in London, in September.

New pieces include large loosely thrown cylinders and dishes and black stoneware bottles, inspired by the bottle kilns of Stoke on Trent. All pieces are handmade in the UK.
